

Strengthening the capacity of non-governmental organizations and individuals dealing with issues of truth and reconciliation

From the 1st of July 2008th to the 1st of May 2009th the activities of the Truth and Reconciliation program implemented in the framework of the project entitled Strengthening the capacity of non-governmental organizations and individuals dealing with issues of truth and reconciliation. The aim of the project was to strengthen the capacity of organizations and individuals involved in issues of truth reconciliation in Serbia, through the development of dialogue, exchange of experiences and cooperation, as well as by increasing the overall level of knowledge and communication skills, and develop the capacity of the Association through its connection with similar initiatives in other states of the former Yugoslavia. During the project, the following activities were realized:

1. There were held two joint and several individual meetings with representatives of the victims of the war in order to include them in activities ZAIP (October 2008th and January 2009th).
2. A meeting of the Coordination Committee of the Association in Belgrade - January 2009th.
3. ZAIP three-day seminar titled "The needs of victims of war and how to achieve them", which was intended to strengthen the capacity of organizations to deal with the victims of war reconciliation. The seminar was held on Zlatibor, from the 3rd to the 5th of April 2009th. Facilitators and speakers at the seminar were: Prof. Dr. Vesna Nikolić-Ristanović, Prof. Dr. Jelena Srna and Ivana Vidaković.
4. Presentation of the ZAIP activities at conferences at home and abroad.
