

Monitoring system of referral mechanism and protection of women victims of trafficking in Serbia

Victimology Society of Serbia, through the UNDP / EU and with the institutional support of the Bureau of Gender Equality, Ministry of Labour and Social Policy, on the implementation of the project Monitoring system of referral mechanism and protection of women victims of trafficking in Serbia. The main objective of the project was to propose a model for monitoring and evaluation mechanisms and referral systems to protect victims of human trafficking. The project was realized from 23rd of April 2009th to 25th of January 2010th.

The project included the following activities:

1. Training for trial monitoring and support victims / witness in court, 16th and 17th of June 2009th.
2. Collecting data on individual cases of juvenile and adult females in Serbia, as well as the type of intervention of relevant state structures and NGOs in these cases.
3. Data processing and analysis as well as other written materials and writing of the report, including making recommendations for reform / improvement mechanisms for combating trafficking, monitoring and evaluation. The research report will be published in the book form in Serbian.

The project was implemented through the UNDP program funded by *the EU*.
