

The Power of Change - The Power of Prevention of Gender-Based Violence in Serbia

The project Power of Change - Power of Prevention of Gender-Based Violence in Serbia is being implemented within the United Nations Trust Fund to End Violence against Women (UNTF EVAW). The project should contribute to the reduction of harmful, gender-based stereotypes related to discrimination and violence against women and girls - through raising the level of knowledge and information of young people and the impact on changing negative attitudes and behaviors. The Victimology Society of Serbia is one of the eight organizations participating in the project. The activities are carried out in eight cities/municipalities in Serbia: Kraljevo, Novi Sad, Zaječar, Novi Beograd, Čelarevo, Aleksinac, Prijepolje and Sombor.

The main activities within the project are:

Activity 1: Accredited 'Power of Change' training to form and lead support and self-help groups for women survivors of violence or prevention workshops for girls

Activity 2: Organization and realization of a series of workshops for girls according to the model 'Power of change'

Activity 3: Organizing a "Live Library" event

Activity 4: Implementing StepUp! campaign: Distribution of WAVE network materials at the local community level

Activity 5: Support to a group of young people in organizing local advocacy activities for the prevention of gender-based violence

Activity 6: Sharing information about the 'Power of Change - Power of Prevention' campaign via social networks

Activity 7: Participation in the final conference of the project

The project is being implemented from 10.6.2020 - 30.9.2022.
