

## **„2Gether4Victims-Coordinating and harmonising Generic and Specialist Support services for victims of gender-based violence“**

The Victimology Society is implementing a project entitled *„2Gether4Victims-Coordinating and harmonising Generic and Specialist Support services for victims of gender-based violence“*. The project aims to improve the provision of support services for victims of gender-based and domestic violence in a gender-sensitive manner, as well as to enhance the system for assessing victims' individual needs. The project seeks to identify gaps in the organisation of responses and support for victims of gender-based violence, recognize examples of good practice within generic and specialist support services, and contribute to the development of a tailored, comprehensive, and victim-centred approach to support through the implementation of two tools: the Individual Support Needs Assessment Tool for Victims of Gender-Based Violence/Domestic Violence (INA) and the Organisational Self-Assessment (OSA) tool.

The project is coordinated by Victim Support Europe, and partners include, among others, APAV | Associação Portuguesa de Apoio à Vítima, FEM – Feministas em Movimento Associação, Udruga za podršku žrtvama i svjedocima, Ženska soba – Centar za seksualna prava, VILIAS, Veda Vidus, Mykolo Romerio Universitetas, ANDAVI – France Victimes 58, SPAVO, Slachtofferhulp Nederland, together with associated partner La Strada International. The project is funded through the European Commission's CERV programme. The project is being implemented from May to October 2026.
