

Developing mechanisms to monitor the process of issuing temporary residence permits for victims of trafficking and prosecution of trafficking in Serbia

This project was implemented in the second half of the 2005th year, in cooperation with the International Organization for Migration in Belgrade. The aim of the project was to create a mechanism to monitor the proposal of trafficking in Serbia, with a special emphasis on monitoring the process of issuing temporary residence permits for victims of trafficking and prosecution of cases of trafficking in human beings in Serbia.

Activities:

- Informing the members of the National Team for Combating Trafficking in Human Beings about the project; □
- Connecting with relevant institutions and non-governmental organizations; □
- Collect data on existing records on human trafficking and cases of human trafficking in Serbia and their processing; process of issuing temporary residence permits for foreign nationals as victims of trafficking in Serbia and the number of permits issued; existing legislation concerning the statistical surveys, keeping records and prosecution traceability of human trafficking; existing legal regulations regarding issuance of residence permits for foreign nationals as victims of trafficking in human beings; □
- Connecting with partners on the program in Bosnia and Croatia and participation in the first coordination meeting in Belgrade on the 26th of July 2005th; □
- Organizing Roundtable- □ Temporary residence permit for victims of trafficking and the jurisdiction of Serbia, Belgrade, 6th of December 2005th;
- Writing a monitoring mechanism of trafficking cases that will be published in a joint publication with the results of the project partners from Bosnia and Croatia. □
