

Developing methods of monitoring the implementation of laws and practices related to violence against women in Serbia

Continuation of the project, which started in 2010th in collaboration with UN Women. VDS role in the realization of this project was to develop a methodology of monitoring the implementation of laws and practices related to violence against women in Serbia and to realize pilot study. In the 2011th collecting data from court cases, as well as processing and data analysis, was finished. Prof. Vesna Nikolić-Ristanović analyzed the obtained data, and wrote a study called Monitoring application of legislation and polices regarding violence against women in Serbia: a pilot survey findings, which in September 2011th was presented at the meeting of the Gender Theme Group, which brings together representatives from government institutions and non-governmental organizations.

In the project implementation directly were involved: Prof. Vesna Nikolić-Ristanović (UNIFEM consultant to develop a methodology for monitoring the implementation of laws and practices related to violence against women in Serbia), Dr. Sanja Čopić, Ljiljana Stevković and Natalija Cecelja (collecting data from court cases) and Bejan Šaćiri (data entry and processing).
