

Improving the implementation strategy of national action plans to combat human trafficking in the countries in the Stabilisation and Association Process (the Enhancement of Implementation Strategies for National Anti-Trafficking Action Plans in the SAP countries)

The project was implemented from July of 2004th to end of 2005th, in cooperation with ICMPD, Vienna (International Centre for Migration Policy and Development), an NGO Women's Room from Croatia and LaStrada from Moldova. The aim of the project was to support country teams and civil society in the development and implementation of national action plans.

The 2005th the following activities were completed:

- Participation in meetings (together with representatives of the ICMPD) with the National Coordinators for combating trafficking in human beings and members of the national teams of Serbia and Macedonia;
- Participation in meetings of the project team;
- Updating the database of NGOs in Serbia, Macedonia and Albania to deal with the problems of human trafficking (the roster NGOs);
- Analysis of the old national plans of action for Serbia, Macedonia and Albania, as well as the drafting of new national strategies and action plans;
- Creating / modifying tables to monitor the implementation of the national plan of action in Serbia;
- Regular information of ICMPD about the specific activities which are taken in the fight against human trafficking in Serbia as well as current events, seminars, round table discussions on the issue of trafficking in human beings;
- Participation in regional seminars in Vienna from 21st to 23rd of April 2005th (dr Vesna Nikolić-Ristanović) and on Ohrid from 21st to 23rd of November 2005th (mr Sanja Čopić).

In the implementation of the project directly were involved dr Vesna Nikolić-Ristanović and mr Sanja Čopić, and also was involved Olivera Simić, in the part of the activities during the 2005th.
